## IF YOU GROW PRODUCE

Annual registration is a <u>requirement</u> for all farms growing, harvesting, packing, and holding produce for public consumption. An Exemption form can be filled out once registration is completed. #### IF YOU USE PESTICIDES

### IF YOU RAISE LIVESTOCK

# IF YOU HAVE A GREENHOUSE/NURSERY

Annual licensing is required prior to offering for sale nursery stock, which is hardy plants with a persistent woody stem that are capable of propagation. A <u>Nursery Worker's License</u>, inspection, and certification is needed for offering for sale nursery stock that you grow or propagate. A <u>Nursery Stock Dealer's License</u> is needed if you don't grow or propagate but you offer for sale nursery stock that you obtain from another licensed nursery or dealer. # FARM, FOREST, OPEN SPACE + APIARIES

Farmland Designation Program (Under Farm, Forest, and Open Space): Farms earning \$2,500 or more gross annual income from farming activity are eligible for the Farmland Designation Program, which offers property tax reductions for their farm. If you are importing or exporting live bees, hives, or used equipment it is required to obtain an Apiary Entry Permit.
